



WHO WE'RE LOOKING FOR

We're currently recruiting for a Chair and between 4 - 6 Committee members to support Ministry of Stories from April 2020 until the end of March 2021.

Essential skills and experience:

- Well-connected within the London corporate sector (wealth management / financial, legal, property development/ tech/ media and press/ construction/ IP/ HR) and willingness and ability to introduce their network to Ministry of Stories without a conflict of interest.

OR

- Well connected with high net-worth individuals or decision-makers in business or able to gain access to talent/ in-kind donations

Desirable skills and experience:

- Ability to persuade others as to the importance of writing, arts or culture in society.
- Existing knowledge of Ministry of Stories and/or connections with the arts or cultural sector.

REQUIREMENTS OF THE ROLE

Essential requirements:

- Ability to attend a schedule of 10th birthday committee meetings, scheduled in advance for 2020.
- Ability to attend occasional one-to-one meetings with members of the Development Team, expected to take place every 2 months between April 2020 - March 2021
- Commitment to support Ministry of Stories in fundraising - including making business and individual introductions, selling tables to our 10th Birthday Party, sourcing 'money can't buy' opportunities for auction etc.
- Commitment to work to a collective financial target.

Desirable requirements:

- Ability to persuade others to make financial donations to Ministry of Stories, by being a donor - personally or professionally - themselves. There is no requirement on the scale of donation, it is the power of being able to declare you are a donor that is important.
